X Procedure for medical subsidies update of single parent families **X**

- When: June 1 (Tue) 30 (Wed), 9:00 am 5:00 pm (if sent by mail, must arrive within this period)
- Who: Single mother, single father families whose household is non-taxable for income-tax
- What to prepare: Notification, health insurance card (for every family member), etc.
- How to apply: Fill in the required information on the application form and directly bring it to the Numazu city hall or mail it.
 - * We will send the application form to people eligible for the qualification update at the end of May.
 - X If you would like to newly apply for medical subsidies, please contact us in June.

★ Health center Information ★

- What: Health center carries out various lectures and enlightenment activities so that the citizens are able to lead healthy lives. Please use the services to live long, vivid lives.
- ♦ Through May 31st to June 6th is a smoking cessation week. May 31st is International No Smoking Day Smoking is reported to increase not only the smoker but the people around that person's risk of cancers and ischemic heart disease. The reason behind being unable to give up smoking is not because of a weak will but because of the strong addiction of nicotine. Smoking cessation consultation of the health center thinks with you, "the suitable smoking cessation method" and supports you. Want you to aim for smoking cessation with our support rather than try it by yourself?

♦ About the check-up of HIV, syphilis, hepatitis viruses

Check-ups are free but reservation-system only. The check-up for HIV (AIDS), syphilis, hepatitis B and C can be undergone anonymously.

When: 3 times in a month, Tuesday (For June, enforce 4 times)

Where: Eastern prefecture health center (Takashima Hon-cho)

Application method: By telephone (reservation is required)

1 The checkup can be undergone anonymously. Please tell the reception number issued when you booked on the day of check-up.

♦Let's take the specific medical check-up and cancer check-up!

This year's Numazu city medical check-up will begin from June 14th (Mon) until October 30th (Sat)

The Numazu city medical check-up ticket will be sent to eligible citizens in early June. For those who are willing to take the medical check-up but has not received the medical check-up ticket, please contact the health center. During the second half of the medical check-up, the medical institution may be crowded since you may not get the check-up at where you desire. We recommend you for an early medical check-up.

♦Free coupon for Cervical cancer and breast cancer medical check-ups would be sent to women who are within the target age.

The earlier the cancer is detected, the chances for recovery are higher. For this, a medical checkup is necessary. In our city, we send free coupon ticket to the subjects listed below at the beginning of June to disseminate the right knowledge about cancer and the required examination. Please contact the health center (Hoken center) if you have not received it to your registered address because of transfers and others.

 - 2. The expiration date of your health insurance card will be shorter.
 - 3. You will need to pay 100% medical expenses once.

X Child's allowance will be provided on June 11th (Fri) **X**

- What: We will payout Child's allowance for 4 months; February to May. (For those who have started receiving from March, it will be from the start month to May.)
 - The people who are receiving the allowance, a status report (Genkyo Todoke) will be delivered
 in the middle of June, so please fill it in and submit it. Please look at the city's home page for
 people who are looking for information on how to apply for status report (Genkyo Todoke).
- Caution: If you will not submit the status report, you will not be able to receive the child's allowance from June.

• What: Please follow the basic rule of distinguishing the trash.

In order to reduce the trash and can be reused them again, the trash is distinguished into different categories. Garbage must be separated into the following 4 different categories and have to be thrown away by 8:00 am on the designated date in the designated areas.

Burnable garbage day (Twice a week) Kitchen waste, used tissues, garbage tha needs to be sanitized.	Plastic packaging and containers day (Once a week) Plastic, vinyl containers and packaging (Look for the "Plastic Mark").
Recyclable garbage day (Once a month) Cans, bottles, metals, used paper, PET bottles battery, and lighter etc.	Landfill waste day (Once a month) Crockery, glass, futon, carpet, wooden products, plastic products etc.

^{*} Garbage separation app Sana-ru: You can check information about the guide and garbage collection days from your smartphone. You can also confirm about garbage separation and the garbage collection day.

Let's reduce the amount of garbages!!

Last year, the amount of garbage was 58509 tons and it has been reduced 3.9% compared to the previous year because of the reduction by the covid-19. However, garbage from houses has increased.

It is necessary for each person to work on reducing the garbage for a better environment. Additionary, draining water and using up all of the ingredients will connect to the reduction of garbage as well.

★ Evacuation information has been changed ★

In the event of a flood or sediment disaster, the description of the evacuation information that informs you of the timing of evacuation has been changed. Please take appropriate evacuation actions according to the situation in the event of a disaster.

Due to the revision of the law, each has been changed from May 20th

- Warning Level 3 "Preparation for Evacuation, Evacuation of the Elderly and etc." \rightarrow "Evacuation of the Elderly and etc."
- Warning Level 4 "Evacuation advisory/evacuation instruction (emergency)" → "Evacuation instruction"
- Warning Level 5 "Disaster Occurrence Information" → "Emergency safety guarantees"
- If a warning level 3 or 4 is issued, please evacuate to a safe place immediately.

★ Declaration on Income for National Health Insurance holders ★

- What: If you did not have any salary for the past year (Reiwa 2; 2020), or if you do not need to inform information about your income (due to survivor's pension, disability pension and non-taxable pensions.), declaration may occasionally cut your insurance fee. If you fit in such categories, please consult by June 11th (Fri).
- Persons who fall under the following do not need to declare.
 - 1. Those who have already declared income tax and resident tax.
 - 2. Those who have been receiving national pension or employee pension etc.
 - 3. When your employer has submitted a salary payment report to city hall.

- What: People who have turned 40 years or older as of April 1st 2021 and have joined the national health insurance before Reiwa 2 (2020) April 1st, and who have paid all the insurance premiums up to fiscal year of Reiwa 2.
- Who: 350 people (first arrival)
- **Subsidy**: 40,000 yen (Copayment will be depending on medical institutions.)
- **How to apply**: Visit National Health Insurance Division with National Health Insurance card or by phone. (As a general rule, the application procedure is limited to the person or a member of the same household.)
- When: Apply between June 10th (Thu) Reiwa 4 (2022) February 28th(Mon)
- Check up duration: July 1st (Thu)- Reiwa 4 (2022) March 31st (Thu)
- X Depending on the status of the spread of COVID-19 infection, the content of the examination may be changed, postponed or canceled.

- What: COVID-19 vaccine reservation is recommended that you apply online. Please ask your family or friends for help if you have any problems.
 - Also, vaccine counselors are assigned in each district center to explain about reservation websites and how to operate smartphones.
- Who: People who will make a reservation but don't know how to do it
- Where :District Centers in the city (Heda area: Health Center, Heda branch)
- When: Tuesday-Friday until June 30th (Wed), 9:00 am-5:00 pm

**** Have you completed the antibody test and vaccination for the Rubella test?**

• What: You can receive antibody tests and vaccination for rubella test free of charge. Men who were born between April 2, 1962, and April 1, 1979, had no opportunity for routine immunization and had a low rubella antibody prevalence, so until Feb. 28, 2022, using coupons, you can get a rubella antibody test and vaccine free of charge. Coupons have been shipped to all eligible people in 2019 and 2020. Those with low antibody titers as a result of antibody testing should be vaccinated. If you have lost your coupon, please contact the Health Center.

Subsidy for rubella antibody test costs: We are subsidizing the antibody test fee of rubella for the purpose of reducing the anxiety towards delivery and sustaining the health of children by preventing the congenital rubella syndrome.

 - 3. Cohabitant of pregnant female with low rubella antibody titers
- Application deadline: Monday, Feb. 28, 2022

Subsidy for rubella vaccination: It is important to carry out a rubella antibody test and to vaccinate people with low antibody titers. The city subsidizes part of the inoculation cost.

 - 3. Cohabitant of pregnant female
- Grant amount: Rubella vaccine: 4,000 yen / Measles-rubella mixed vaccine: 5,000 yen.
- Application due date: March 31st (Thu) 2022
