• What: Important information about heatstroke and food poisoning

♦ Be careful about heatstroke ◆

Heatstroke occurs not only in midsummer, but it also occurs in the rainy season when the humidity is high. Be sensitive about changes in your condition and try to prevent heatstroke.



Heatstroke alert

We will inform you when the risk of heatstroke is extremely high as a "heat stroke warning alert" by radio system etc.

Points for heatstroke prevention

- 1. Make good use of air conditioner etc. and be careful of room temperature.
- 2. Wear a hat or use a parasol when you go outside.
- 3. Hydrate frequently even before you feel thirsty.
- 4. Do not overdo and rest if you feel hot and tired.
- 5. Eat nutritious food and sleep, and get enough rest.

♦ Be careful about food poisoning ◆

Let's follow the three principles of "Do not spread bacteria, Do not allow bacteria to multiply, Destroy bacteria" the causative bacteria and viruses of food poisoning. Seek medical attention early if you are vomiting or diarrhea due to food poisoning.

Points for food poisoning prevention

1. Do not spread bacteria

Thoroughly wash food, cooking utensils, fingers, etc.

2. Do not allow bacteria to multiply

Do not leave food at room temperature and put in the refrigerator.
