### ✧ Vaccination Information ✧

- **What:** Infectious diseases, including but not limited to coronavirus, can be life-threatening. Please take this opportunity to consider vaccination to protect yourself and your loved ones. **We will extend the period of antibody testing and immunization for adult patients with rubella until the end of February, 2025.**
  - **Details:** Men who have not had the opportunity to be routinely immunized against rubella may have a lower antibody count against rubella than other generations and can be tested for antibodies using vouchers. Those with a low antibody count because of the test can be vaccinated. Both testing and vaccination are free of charge.
  - **Who:** Males born between April 2, 1962 and April 1, 1979  
(Coupons were already sent to all eligible persons in 2019 and 2020.)
- \*Coupons can be used until February 28, 2023 (Tuesday).  
\*If you lost your coupon, please contact the Health Promotion division.

### ✧ We will send you a vaccination ticket for cervical cancer prevention vaccine ✧

- **Who:** ① Women who were born between April 2, 2006 and April 1, 2010  
② Women who were born between April 2, 1997 and April 1, 2006. ( Women who missed the window of vaccination period due to its unpopularity.)  
Person applies ① → The vaccination ticket has already been sent to eligible persons. Please see the brochure for more detail.

Person applies ② → Eligible persons will be sent a vaccination ticket as soon as it is ready after the information is provided by the government.

- **Who:** The applicant must meet all the following requirements:

1. Applicant who have relatives living together or considering living together.  
\*The following units are available to single persons aged 60 or above or those who are certified as a person of disability: For Jiyugaoka danchi – 2 units, Korinbayashi danchi, Nakao danchi - 1 unit, Okubo danchi – 2 units, Matsubara danchi – 1 unit, Hara danchi – 7 units, Hara machinaka danchi – 3 units, Imazawa danchi, Yae danchi, Green Hills Yutaka – 1 unit and Fugaku danchi.
2. Applicable to the income base stipulated in the regulations.
3. The applicant lives or works in the city
4. Currently in need of housing
5. Not a member of a violent crime syndicate (including those housemates together), etc.

\* Those who wish to apply for the first time are requested to come to the City Hall's 6<sup>th</sup> floor House Building and Repairs division before the deadline for application. For more details, please contact us or visit the city website.

## ✧ Application for receiving a subsidy for brain medical checkup of the latter-stage elderly healthcare system ✧

- **Consultation period:** July 1 (Fri) – December 31 (Sat)
- **Who:**
  - Those living in Numazu city, insured by the latter-stage elderly healthcare system.
  - Those who have paid in full last fiscal year's insurance premium.
  - Those who did not receive a subsidy last fiscal year.
- ✧ People born prior to August 31, 1947 can also apply. (the consultation will be available after their 75th birthday)
- **Quota:** Maximum of 130 people (Lottery will be held in case of too many applicants.)
- **Amount of subsidy:** 30,000 yen (the charge for individuals will differ with each medical institutions)
- **Application:** By telephone (Please prepare your insurance card when you apply.)
- **Application period:** May 16 (Mon) - June 15 (Wed)
