% Let's follow the basic rules when throwing away garbage %

To reduce and to recycle the garbage, garbage is collected by separating it in categories. The garbage must be separated as follows and put out by 8am on the designated date and area.

(Once a week)
Plastic, vinyl containers and packaging with plastic mark
Landfill waste day (Once a month)
Potteries, glass products, futon, wooden furniture, plastic products and so on.

You can easily check how to separate and dispose of garbage, collection date, etc. with the application "さんあ~る" (san-aru) and the guidebook called "ごみの分別・減量ガイドブック" (gomi no bunbetu・ genryo guidebook). Please visit the city website for more details.

▲Flaming and smoking hazards have been occurring a lot. Put electronic cigarettes in the collection container of "batteries and lighters" on the day of recyclable garbage!

Twice last year and once in April, smoke problems occurred at the recycling facility due to the mixing of dangerous things such as electronic cigarettes in "the plastic packaging and containers garbage" handed over by the city. There is always a risk of fire, so please cooperate in separating garbage properly.

\star Subsidy for infertility and recurrent pregnancy loss treatments \star

We subsidize part of the treatment expenses for couples who wish to get pregnant but suffer from infertility and recurrent pregnancy loss.

- **The eligible treatment:** General infertility treatment (include artificial insemination), specific infertility treatment (include male infertility treatment), recurrent pregnancy loss treatment
- **Subsidy amount:** A half of copayment cost paid for the target treatments. Up to 300,000 yen in a fiscal year per couple.

\star Please be aware of the heatstroke and food poisoning \star

♦ Be aware of heatstroke

Heatstroke is caused by three factors: "temperature", "humidity" and "radiant heat (heat transmitted from the ground and buildings). It occurs not only in the hot summer but also in the humid rainy season. Be aware of changes in your physical condition and try to prevent it.

Points for heatstroke prevention

- 1. Make good use of air conditioners, fans and so on and check room temperature.
- 2. Wear a hat or use a parasol when you go outside.
- 3. Hydrate frequently even before you feel thirsty.
- 4. If you feel hot or tired, take a rest.

Heatstroke alert

We will inform you when the risk of heatstroke is extremely high as a "heat stroke warning alert" by public address system etc. When the alert is announced, please try to prevent heatstroke even more.

♦ Be careful about food poisoning♦

Let's keep the following three principles to prevent food poisoning; "Do not spread, Do not allow to multiply, Destroy".

Points for food poisoning prevention

- 1. Do not spread bacteria Thoroughly wash food, cooking utensils, fingers, etc.
- Do not allow bacteria to multiply Do not leave food at room temperature and put them in the refrigerator to keep them under 10 °C.

3. Destroy bacteria

Thorough heating of food and sterilization of cooking utensils

If you get food poisoning...

Vomiting and diarrhea due to food poisoning are the body's defense reactions. Get medical attention as soon as possible without taking over-the-counter medicines.

➢ Information from the Consumer Affairs Center ⅔

• What: Due to a revision of the Civil Code, the age of majority has been lowered from 20 to 18 on April 1st. Please be aware of the following points to prevent the increase in consumer damage among young people.

You lose these rights when you turn 18!

When a minor reaches the majority age, they lose the "minor's right of rescission," which allows them to rescind or cancel a contract made by a minor without the consent of a guardian.

• Details:

Examples of problems of concern

- Young people with limited social experience and knowledge of contracts end up signing contracts without understanding the details.
- The age of persons being targeted by cruel business practices, such as post-employment pyramid schemes; aimed at young people is becoming younger.
- Young people are forced to sign up for credit contract or borrow money even if they refuse the solicitation, saying they have no money, and end up owing more than they can repay.

Consider how to deal with the situation.

✓ Think carefully before you sign a contract

Do not sign a contract immediately, even if you are forced to do so, but consult with a trusted family member or friend before deciding.

✓ Do not believe in profit-making stories.

There is no easy way to make a lot of money. Even if you see words in SNS and online advertisements that you can easily earn, don't believe it right away and stay calm. Think of it as suspicious to teach others how to make money easily.

 \checkmark If you are pressured to sign a contract, refuse firmly.

You may get into trouble later if you sign a contract on the spot as they tell you. If the contract is not necessary immediately, refuse it firmly and courageously.

℅ National Pension Exemption System ※

- What: If your previous year's income has been under a certain amount and have trouble with the payment of the premium, do not leave the unpaid amount but apply for exemption. Once it's approved, the premium will be completely or partially exempted. In addition, there is a payment deferment system available only for people who are under 50 years old, and payment will be deferred if approved.
 *You can apply retroactively up to 2 years and one month from the time of the application submission.
 *Related to COVID-19, applications for exemption between July and June, 2023 will still be available.
