# lpha Subsidy for medical expenses for hospitalization of persons with mental disorders lpha

- Subsidy: One-third of the amount after deducting the high cost medical expenses from the copayment.
- Who:
  - ① Persons with mental disorders who live in the city and have been hospitalized for more than three months in a row.
  - ② Person who received this medial expense subsidy is readmitted within 6 months after discharge
- How to apply: Submit the required documents directly.
- **Application period:** One year from the month of medical treatment covered by the grant to the same month of the following year

### **X** Take the hepatitis test **X**

- What: From July 25 (Mon) to July 31 (Sun) is "Liver Week", July 28 (Thu) is Japan's hepatitis day. Hepatitis is a condition where your liver is inflamed because of a virus. By finding the infection of the virus, and treating it in its early stage, you can prevent it from getting worse, and/or completely recover. We are sending a Numazu city health examination ticket so check it out.

- Examination limit: October 31 (Mon)


- \* There is a limit to the number of parking spaces available in a residence.

    - Must have relatives living together or considering living together.
       \*The following units are available to single persons aged 60 or above or those who are certified as a person of disability: For Jiyugaoka danchi, Yae danchi and Uematsu Y Kopo 1 unit.
    - 2. Applicable to the income base stipulated in the regulations.
    - 3. Must live or work in the city
    - 4. Currently in need of housing
    - 5. Not a member of a violent crime syndicate (including those housemates together), etc.
    - \* Those who wish to apply for the first time are requested to come to House Building and Repairs division, 6<sup>th</sup> floor, City Hall before the deadline for application.

- **Study support for children:** Targeting junior high students and parents of households that are in financial need. The support is provided for study and dropout prevention.
- **Support for ensuring housing:** We will conditionally pay the amount equivalent to the rent for a certain period of time to those who have lost their residence due to decrease in income or who are having trouble paying the rent.
