When you bring in your garbage, please wear a mask, disinfect your hands at the reception desk, and carry it to the designated area by yourself. Please minimize the amount of garbage you bring and put it out at the designated area on collection days, to avoid overcrowding.

- **Precautions when disposing:**
 - Please follow the instructions of the staff as it can be dangerous inside the centre.
 - Spray cans and gas canisters, etc. may explode, so please empty them.
 - Please disassemble furniture.
 - Please separate the garbage before bringing in.
- **What you cannot dispose:**
 - Large amounts of Styrofoam, plastics, and industrial waste generated during business activities.
 - Tires, waste oil, hazardous and toxic substances, construction waste, etc.
 - Home appliances (TVs, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers, air conditioners), personal computers, motorcycles
- **Fee for disposal** (depends on the maximum loading capacity of the vehicle used)

1,240 yen per vehicle up to the maximum loading capacity of 200 kg If the maximum loading capacity exceeds 200 kg, 620 yen per 100 kg will be charged.	1,240 yen per vehicle
