


Examinations for HIV, syphilis and Hepatitis

- What: The "Numazu City Health Checkup ticket" will be sent to those who are eligible at the beginning of June. If you have not received a ticket and wish to take the health checkup, please contact us. Since medical facilities are very crowded during the latter half of the checkup period, we recommend that you visit the medical institutions as early as possible.

% Procedure for updating eligibility for single-parent families medical expenses subsidies %

- When: June 1 (Thu) 30 (Fri), 9:00 17:00
- Eligibility: Single parents whose households are exempt from income tax.
- **How to apply:** Send the application form by mail or in person (must arrive by deadline)
- *When you bring your application in person, you must bring the notification letter, health insurance card (for all eligible applicants), and some need more information.
- *Eligible applicants would receive application forms by mail at the end of May.
- *Applicants who newly apply for a medical subsidy should contact us by the end of June.

- What: Due to system maintenance, issuance services at convenience stores for resident certificate (*Jumin hyo*) etc. will be suspended all day.

X For people whose child benefit eligibility was terminated in the previous year due to excess income (ineligible for payment) *

Child benefits during the period from June 2023 till May 2024 will be examined based on the total income period from January 1 to December 31 of Reiwa 4.

People who were ineligible for benefits in the previous year, and may be eligible for benefits this time need to reapply for a new application for certification.

Child benefit is paid from the month following the request.

Those who have outstanding national health insurance contributions up to the previous year should pay them as soon as possible. Outstanding payments may result in the following benefit restrictions.

- Unable to receive subsidies for medical examinations and brain examinations
- The validity period of national health insurance card is shortened
- Need to pay all the medical expenses

※ Infertility Medical treatment support ※

For couples (including those in common-law marriages) who wish to conceive but are suffering from infertility or Recurrent Pregnancy Loss, subsidies are provided to cover part of the cost of treatment. The eligibility has been extended from 'first and second child' to 'no restrictions'.

- Eligible Treatments: General infertility treatment (including artificial insemination), Assisted reproductive technology (including male infertility treatment), Recurrent pregnancy loss treatment
- **Grant amount:** 1/2 of the self-payment amount spent on treatment, up to a maximum of ¥300,000 per couple per fiscal year.
- **Grant period:** 5 fiscal years in total

X Lifesaving Seminar: Ordinary First Aid Course Ⅲ X

lpha Ensure early evacuation in the event of wind and flood damage lpha

The June-October period is prone to disasters caused by heavy rainfall and other natural disasters. The city will provide information and open shelters according to the situation. We encourage everyone to collect information and to take early action to save lives.

Let's stay prepared.

Confirm the hazards around you

Identify the anticipated flood zone and landslide warning zone and understand in advance the need to evacuate.

*The various hazard maps are available on the city website.

Information tool / service

The national, prefectural and municipal authorities update and share the information on wind and flood damage in real time. Try to check them regularly on the internet or by using a TV controller. Check the system on a regular basis. Evacuation information and river level information can also be checked via the "d button" on the TV remote control.

Consider evacuating to other places besides the evacuation shelters

Consider evacuation options, such as to relatives and friends living in safe areas, or to the second floor of your home (vertical evacuation).

Check for essentials

Make sure you have essentials such as food, drink and medicines to take.

Determine your "MyTimeline"

"MyTimeline" is a personal evacuation action plan for wind and flood disasters, organized in chronological order according to your own family compositions and community situations. Discuss with your family what you will do before a disaster occurs and before you evacuate.

▶Accommodation subsidy scheme

Subsidies are available for people with evacuation concerns, such as those who require nursing care 3 or more or have a disability certificate, if they use accommodation designated by the city.

lpha How to receive the National Health Insurance Card at renewal lpha

The National Health Insurance card (and Elderly Recipient Certificate) will be updated on August 1. The new Health Insurance Card will be delivered by regular postal mail. Upon application, this can be changed to over the counter or by registered mail.

- **How to apply:** In person or by phone by June 1, 5:15 p.m.

- What: The insurance premium may be reduced by the declaration for people who did not have income from January 1 to December 31 of 2022 or people who do not need to declare their income under tax law (such as those whose income is only non-taxable pensions such as survivor's pension, disability pension, etc),. If eligible for it, please contact us by June 9. Those who have filed income tax and resident tax, those who have received national pension or employee pension, and those whose employer have submitted a salary payment report do not need to declare.

- Consultation period: Saturday, July 1,2023 Friday, March 29,2024
- **Who:** People over 40 years as of April 1, old who continuously subscribe to the national health insurance from before April 1, 2022 until the day of consultation, and has completed the payment of the insurance premiums up to Reiwa 4 fiscal year.
 - Quota: 350 people (first come, first serve)
 - Subsidy: 40,000 yen (The amount to be paid by each patient will depend on the medical institution)
- How to apply: By phone or in person at the counter with your insurance card. (As a
 general rule, the application procedure is limited to the person themself or a member of the
 same household)
- **Application period:** Tuesday, June 13, 2023 Thursday, February 29, 2024 *Please visit city website to check if there are any changes.
