Many incidents involving the spontaneous combustion and smoking of rubbish have occurred!!

Please ensure "proper waste separation."

In October 2023, A fire broke out in a garbage truck while collecting and transporting 'landfill waste class 3 (plastic waste for heat source use)' from a local refuse collection station.

To prevent fire accidents, we ask for your cooperation in ensuring 'proper waste separation'.

Besides the incident in October, a smoke incident has also occurred at a recycling processing facility in July this year, which is considered to have been caused by rechargeable batteries in plastic containers and packaging handed over by the city.

Fortunately, in both cases, there were no injuries and the fire did not spread to the surrounding area, however, damage to collection vehicles and treatment facilities could result in a situation where garbage collection and disposal are disrupted.

Lighters, rechargeable batteries, and other types of batteries and electrical appliances with built-in batteries can cause ignition accidents if mixed with plastic containers and packaging.

About the separation of waste that may cause ignition

◆Dry cell batteries · lighters · electronic cigarettes
