Counting Room

Building Area: 32.23m²; Wooden Two-story Building; Sankawarabuki Roofing

The entire west wall that meets the main building on the west side was coated with masonry-style plaster in West-ern-style, the same as the exterior wall on the second floor of the main building.

On the other hand, the part that meets the main building on the north side used a Namako wall to harmonize with the design of the main building.

Since the counting room(Mise) was intended for the clerk's counter and the housekeeper's office, the interior was finished with a simple middle coat, while the inside of the closet was plastered to prevent moisture and insects.
