Main Building

Wooden two-stories building, Building area 266.76 m

According to "Munafuda" (a tag staked to a building's ridgepole), the house framework was completed in 1873. The first floor follows the Japanese style, whereas the second floor was built in a Quasi-Western style. Plaster paintings are arranged in various places. The structure included a bathroom, a kitchen, and a toilet. It is also connected to two other independent buildings: Counting Room and Main Storage.
