North Earthen Storehouse

Building area: 32.23 m, Earthen two-stories building, Sankawarabuki roofing

The exterior walls are covered with black plaster and a black Namako-Kabe (traditional Japanese wall pattern) pattern. The stone stairs and the doorway are installed in two places on the south side of the first floor.

Two continuous eaves courses are installed on the south side of the first floor, and two small windows with small eaves are installed on the south side of the second floor.

The interior is partitioned in the center, with the east side being used as miso storehouse and the west side as rice storehouse.

Inside the Matsushiro Family House, this would be the storehouse with the closest structure to the typical storehouse.
